Name: **BAKER-ROUSE**

Location: At the Greater Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky Airport, on land owned and first deeded to Elijah Rouse. It was restored and landscaped by the Airport Board When building a runway in 1959. Plot was made from original cemetery. Two small cemeteries were found nearby but no markers, other than field stones could be found. (Listed as Garnett Cemetery on Map of Airport.)

COMMENT:

According to the 1850 census, both Elijah and William A. Rouse and Elijah's wife were born in Virginia. At the time, there were at least 26 Rouse families and about 124 people in these families.

In the same census can be found the names of William and Tabitha Tanner. Both were born in Virginia and there are indications they lived in Ohio for at least three years before coming to Kentucky. In 1850 they were neighbors of the Elijah Rouses.

Edwin and Jamima Baker, he was born in Ohio, were also close neighbors of the Rouses. There is probably a relationship in these families.
