This Indenture made this sixteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and four between John Craig senr of the one part and Francis Craig son of said John of the other part both of the county of Boone and state of Kentucky (Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the right natural affection that I the said John do bear unto him the said Francis, I the said John do promise and oblige myself to make or cause to be made, and by these presents do make, give and grant a general warranty Deed, together with a full conveyance of all my right and title of the following tract or parcel of Land to him the said Francis to have and to hold forever, together with its appurtenances to Begin as follows, at two sugar trees corner to a survey made for Joel Early and one other survey of Merry Walkers Near a branch of Garrison run about four miles from the Ohio river it being a part of a 12470 acres survey made for said Walker, running west three hundred poles to a sugar tree and two hickories a corner in said Walkers line, thence South 96, West 440 poles to a corner of a preemption, thence with the end line of said preemption to a corner with said preemption, also corner of Robert Johnson thence with said Johnson's line 730 poles to the Beginning.
